





To Fr. Sadowski, and our dear friends and parishioners at St. Michael Church,

Regarding the recent \$1,910 donation, we would love to share with you our record setting levels of food assistance given this year in our beloved community. With your generous help we have given food to 3,115 Valley neighbors from January to the end of May thus far. These folks coming for help are so grateful and relieved to have their concerns over enough food for themselves and their families satisfied. This allows them to fully concentrate on other aspects of their lives.

Here's a story from our pantry. In June a Mom and Dad with two teen children at home called for emergency food. They didn't have enough left for the weekend. Dad has developed congestive heart failure and can't work now, so they are down to Mom's hourly wage and part-time work of the older teen. They had received help back in 2023 until they found their situation improved but now this recent health set-back came sudden and unexpected. It felt so good to give them six bags of good, healthy food including eggs, frozen chicken, fresh vegetables, bread and some non-perishables like, coffee, cereal, pasta sauce and soup.

We want to convey some of that gratitude so that you feel good too. Thank you because there is such value in your regular support of our pantry.


