

In light of this Jubilee Year of Hope, Pope Leo chose this year's theme "Missionaries of Hope Among All Peoples".

On Sunday, October 19, the second collection that will be taken up is the annual collection to support missionaries who work throughout the world. In the Diocese of Kon Tum, there is a healing ministry at a leprosy colony.
